ANNUAL CHURCH SERVICE FOR THE LAW YEAR FRIDAY, 29 JULY 2022

There will be an Ecumenical Service at St. David's Cathedral, Murray Street, Hobart at 11.00am Friday, 29 July 2022. This service replaces the traditional Opening of the Legal Year service which was postponed in January due to COVID.
